

It is with profound sadness that Children First of the Rockies announces that we will be ceasing services as of August 31, 2020 due to the financial impacts of the CoVID pandemic. For over 20 years, Children First has served the families of Boulder County with supervised parenting services which are essential to the health and well-being of the children of our community. During that time, we have gratefully received the support of state and local governments, many other area non-profits, foundations, private donors, and volunteers without whom we could not have helped the thousands of families and children whose lives we have touched.

While this is an ending, it is also an exciting new beginning, a transformation. As of September 1, 2020, [Boulder Voices for Children](#) will begin offering supervised visitation and parenting coaching services through their new Strengthening Families Therapeutic Supervised Visitation and Exchange Center. Having recently moved into their new nearly 6,000 square foot, residential-style office building in Gunbarrel, replete with 4 child-centered, trauma-informed visitation spaces and a residential-style kitchen, BVFC is able to enhance and expand the services previously offered by Children First.

Knowing that our community will continue to have access to quality supervised parenting services has made this decision for Children First less challenging. Children First and Boulder Voices for Children are committed to working together to ensure as smooth and seamless transition for families currently receiving services as possible.
